Medical Progress Exams are scheduled for all medical and surgical conditions which we think will need a follow up assessment. Adequate follow up on most conditions is necessary to ensure the desired response to treatment is achieved.

With many medical conditions the choice of continued treatment depends on the response the patient is having to the prescribed therapy. If we see the expected response, we will continue the initial treatment or stop treatment if the original condition is resolved.

Occasionally the first choice of medication and therapy may not produce adequate response, necessitating a change to other medications or forms of therapy.

We think medical progress exams are an extremely important part of good medical practice, which is why we offer this exam charge at a reduced rate.

If you have any questions about your pets' scheduled medical progress exam, please ask the doctor, technician or receptionist.

Please note there is a direct cost to the practice for staff time and overhead involved with appointments; therefore it is very important to give us at least 24 hours notice if you are unable to keep this appointment. When a time is reserved for your pet it prevents us from seeing other patients at that time.
